Since 2002, Chiricahua Community Health Centers has been the fortunate recipient of the combined experience, education, and energy of John and Melinda Haun. Dr. John Haun began working, pro bono, at CCHCI's fledgling Douglas Clinic in March of 2002. With many years of experience with chronic disease management, the new national diabetes collaborative caught their attention. Leading a team from CCHCI, presenting at national meetings, they fostered CCHCI's Diabetic Management Program into national recognition for Best Practices.

While he was busy with those activities, Melinda began working toward her Certified Diabetic Educator credential (requiring 4,000 hours of diabetic teaching) which she received in May, 2008. She continues to function as CCHCI's Quality Improvement Coordinator.

These two individuals reflect CCHCI's spirit and commitment to provide quality health care to all in Cochise County. Their faith in goodness, hope for tomorrow, and confidence in doing that which is right inspires us all.

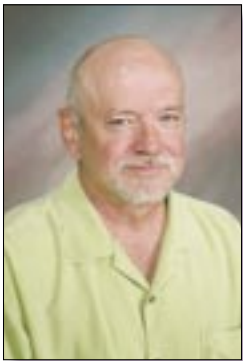
