Job Description

POSITION TITLE: Behavioral Health Professional, Outpatient Clinic

HOURS OF WORK: Monday-Saturday, 40 Hours Per Week, Evenings with some days or Days with some evenings

SUMMARY OF POSITION: Under the direct supervision of the Clinical Director, the Behavioral Health Clinician is responsible for the management and delivery of direct client education and counseling services to assigned individuals and groups participating in TLRC services.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide chemical dependency counseling and DUI screening, education and treatment to individuals/groups in an outpatient clinic setting.
2. Provides intake, assessment and referral services.
3. Document / monitor the documentation of all services provided through client records and data (i.e., demographic data, treatment plans, psychosocial history, progress notes, discharge planning, etc.).
4. Facilitate groups in the areas outlined in the program description and structure of content.
5. Oversees and assists each assigned client with individualized service planning and reviews.
6. Provide culturally sensitive therapy modalities through existing services, outside referral services, or the development of new services.
7. Assist in clinical discharge planning, referring clients to, or providing alternative services.
9. Serves as the "Clinical Liaison" for all assigned clients.
10. Provides reports / other utilization management documents to other agencies involved in a clients care.
11. Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum educational and experience qualifications include any combination of education, professional training or work experience which demonstrates the ability to successfully perform the duties of the position.

1. Minimum 21 years of age.
2. Possess a background in the delivery of individual/group/family counseling services.
3. Familiarity with community resources for referral purposes.
4. Able to function in a teamwork environment.
5. Must be Licensed by the Arizona Board of Behavioral Health Examiners as a Substance Abuse Counselor, Professional Counselor, Marriage & Family therapist, Social Worker or other license as appropriate.
6. Current TB test and physical examination documenting the ability to perform all job duties.
7. Must possess a valid Arizona driver's license.
